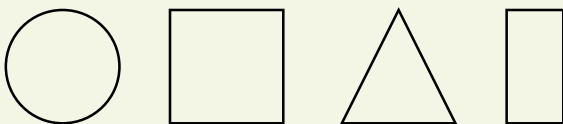
### Research the Artist
